COURSE HEALTH & SAFETY PLAN

All players have a responsibility to ensure they do not endanger fellow players or green staff. Health & Safety considerations are paramount to the smooth running of the Club

Having identified the risks on the course, the following guidance should be considered: -

| Hole 1 | Wait until the 2 nd tee is clear before teeing off |
| Hole 2 | If you think you can drive the green, wait until the green is clear, or the players in front have invited you to tee off. Please also be aware of players on the 4 th green & 5 th tee |
| Hole 3 | Be aware of players on the adjacent 4 th hole |
| Hole 4 | Be aware of players on the adjacent 3 rd hole. Please wait until the 5 th tee is clear before playing your approach to the green |
| Hole 5 | Please allow enough time for the players ahead to be out of range prior to teeing off |
| Hole 6 | Be aware of players on the 9 th tee. Check green is clear before playing your approach shot to the green |
| Hole 7 | Be aware of players teeing off from 8 th tee |
| Hole 8 | When teeing off, be aware of players on 7 th tee and 6 th green. Ensure green is clear before playing approach |
| Hole 9 | Be aware of players on 6 th tee. Wait for the bell to ring before playing your approach shot to the green |

Always be aware of others on the course and shout fore if your ball is heading their way. Patience costs nothing
